



CODE OF CONDUCT – PLAYERS

To ensure an enjoyable and rewarding experience for everyone, all On Target Soccer players are expected to:

- *Respect their coaches*
- *Be supportive and encouraging to their teammates*
- *Respect their opponents – always play fair!*
- *Listen to, and respect the decisions of, the referee*
- *Be gracious in victory and defeat – always shake hands with your opponents and the referee after you have played*
- *Always give 100% effort!*
- *Be honest and trustworthy*
- *Be helpful during, and after, a training session or fixture*
- *Wear the correct kit to training sessions and fixtures*
- *Behave in the right way when at school and home. Any persistent bad behaviour could result in you being suspended from playing until it improves!*
- *Talk to your coach or parent if you're are unhappy with anything when playing (if we don't know, we can't help!)*

Any minor behavioural concerns will be reported to parents/guardians at the end of a training session or fixture. Persistent poor behaviour could result in permanent removal from both training and competitive fixtures. Coaches reserve the right to remove players immediately should they deem it to be necessary to ensure the health, safety and wellbeing of coaches and players.
