



## CODE OF CONDUCT – PARENTS/GUARDIANS

- *Communicate any concerns you may have to our head coaches in a professional and timely manner*
- *Ensure On Target Soccer is kept up-to-date with any change in contact details*

Any behavioural concerns will be discussed with you in a timely and respectful manner. Serious or persistent breach of this code of conduct could result in you being asked not to attend training sessions and fixtures.
